



Macadamia Field Days at Chineka

Sunday 25th May 2008 at 2pm

These provide an opportunity to see bearing 12 - 24 yr old nut trees as well as more recently planted trees and to find out how to get the most out of your macadamias or to assess whether this is the tree crop for you.

The afternoons focus on:-

Varieties, Sourcing plants, Spacings, Vegetation control, Tree Shaping and Pruning, Feeding, Pests, Ripeness, Picking, and Post Harvest Handling.

There will be an opportunity to see the Nut House, and to discuss processing of nut crops; the pitfalls and obligations.

The day is especially intended as an opportunity for people interested in planting nut groves, or have one tree in their garden, or many trees, to learn from the mistakes and observations of others, and to share ideas.

BRING: boots, coats, and questions.

There is a \$45 registration fee per person or \$75 per couple (can be paid online). As numbers are limited, please book early, to avoid disappointment. Complete and return the bottom portion with the fee. Receipts will be issued on the day. The registration fee is not refundable however a credit will be issued, provided 36 hrs notice is given.
